

POST-GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN PUBLIC HEALTH MANAGEMENT (2010-11)

Introduction

The public health challenges being faced all over the world call for the development of capacity in the health systems. This necessitates deploying qualified professionals who can execute and monitor national health policies and programmes, supervise the public health workforce, fully assess the dimensions of public health issues and devise appropriate strategies to meet the emerging challenges. An acute scarcity of public health specialists is being intensely felt, especially in the developing countries. There is a need to devise programmes which will impart the skills required to tackle the existing and emerging public health challenges and to enhance the capacity of the public health managerial workforce in managerial aspects.

Keeping this in view, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), Government of India(GoI) is offering a "One year Post Graduate Diploma in Public Health Management" to the Public Health professionals. The Diploma course has been designed with an aim to develop the capacity of the health practitioners with a focus to bridge the gaps in the public health managerial responsibilities.

This Diploma is being offered in collaboration with Partners in Population and Development (PPD), Bangladesh, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India and National Institute of Health and Family Welfare (NIHFW).

Ten scholarships are offered to the PPD members countries for the professionals working in the field of Public health by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India to enhance the managerial capabilities.

Objective

To enhance the capacity of public health professionals and in turn improve the health status of their country through effective implementation of programmes and public health management.

Course Duration

Residential course of one year duration.

Eligibility

- In-service candidates working in central, state and local governments with at least two years of service in the health sector.
- Applicants should have a Bachelor degree in medical/nursing/health science/natural sciences or Arts.
- The candidate should have been involved in:
 - Public health work at community, hospital or district level,
 - Directorates of health services, public health, family welfare, or in other health-related organizations in the public sector,
 - Preference will be given to in-service candidates nominated by the government,
 - Screening of recommended applicants based on the work experience, background and likely benefits to her/his organization from this training of the candidate will be part of selection process.

Course Focus & Teaching Methods

The Diploma programme has been developed as an interdisciplinary course based on problem solving approach, both in its content and teaching. It utilizes a variety of teaching/learning techniques, including seminars, journal clubs, collaborative learning, group discussions, case studies, lecture discussions, participant assignments, hands-on training on computers, visits to organizations of public health interest, field work, practicum and field projects, apart from class room teaching. Faculty with diverse disciplinary backgrounds, national and international experience combined with a breadth and depth of public health experience are engaged to impart teaching learning experiences.

Project Work

A major strength of the programme is in providing participants with the opportunities to apply learning directly with the community setting. The applied research component serves to ground trainees in "real world" public health applications, and to provide service to the community. Each participant, working under close guidance of a faculty advisor, will develop a 'Project' as part of the course work. The experience has three primary components; a protocol, a written project paper, and an oral presentation. Each student will be evaluated concurrently on the study protocol while the study is in progress and terminally on the submission of project report.

Financial Aspects

Course Fee -Government of India will bear the course fee of Rs. 2.00 lakh (Rupees Two Lakhs only) which includes training material, boarding and lodging.

The Travel/Visa expenses (to and fro) for joining the course will be met by the sponsoring institution/candidate.

- Government of India will provide Rs. 5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) per month as scholarship amount (out of pocket expenses) to each candidate.
- · The candidates would be responsible for initiating and obtaining visa process in their respective countries.
