Dear ASEAN colleagues,

You would recall that Singapore had proposed an ASEAN Health Policy Fellowship at the ASEAN Health Minister's Meeting (AHMM) in 2010. This Fellowship takes the form of an attachment programme for health policymakers from ASEAN countries to spend some time in the Singapore Ministry of Health and Health Promotion Board. The primary objective of this Fellowship is to facilitate exchange of experiences and learning points in healthcare policy-making.

2 The inaugural batch of ASEAN Health Policy Fellows have successfully completed their attachments. The following Fellowship positions for 2013 - 2014 are now open for application:

Subject Area	Number of Places Considered	Duration
Communicable Diseases	2	1 - 4 weeks
Field Epidemiology	2	1 - 4 weeks
Health Promotion	1	4 weeks

3 Applications are open to candidates who are at the level of Assistant or Deputy Directors; Specialists; or Head of Departments who are currently involved in health policy-making in their respective countries. At the end of the Fellowship, each Fellow should provide a report to both Ministries (Singapore and the sending country) on the experiences and learning points acquired from the Fellowship.

4 Singapore will bear the costs of training, as well as provide a stipend to cover local living expenses for the duration of the attachment. The sending country is expected to provide return airfare, as well as cover any existing salaries and taxes payable in the home country.

5 All nominations should be endorsed by the sending Ministry of Health, and submitted using the form attached. Each country may submit more than one application, although each applicant should be nominated for just one Fellowship position. If countries are submitting more than one application, the applicants should be ranked in order of merit or priority. Completed application forms should be submitted to my colleagues at Joanna_Teo@moh.gov.sg or Thomas_Tan@moh.gov.sg, by **30 April 2013**.
